



ICS Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan September 28, 2020 Reconfirmation Meeting

Purpose

This report is intended to document the state requirements regarding the delivery of instruction at ICS. This monthly report will be presented to the ICS Board of Education every 30 days after approval of the Extended COVID-19 Plan and will be posted to the transparency link of the district website. This report meets all legislative requirements and includes additional, recommended disaggregation of data.*

Statute

Sec. 98a(1)(c) Thirty days after the approval of the plan under subsection (2), and every 30 days thereafter, the district must, at a meeting of the board or board of directors, as applicable, of the district, re-confirm how instruction is going to be delivered during the 2020-2021 school year. Public comment must be solicited from the parents or legal guardians of the pupils enrolled in the district during a meeting described in this subdivision.

Sec. 98a(1)(i) The district shall publicly announce its weekly interaction rates under this subdivision at each reconfirmation meeting described in subdivision (c) and make those rates accessible through the transparency reporting link located on the district's website each month.
