Dear Parents,

Throughout the day today, we were notified that two individuals at Borland Elementary have tested positive for COVID-19 and one individual at Imlay City Middle School has been identified with a probable case of COVID-19.

The district has been advised to quarantine students and staff identified as close contacts to these individuals.

Please note, if your child was considered a close contact, you would have already been notified by the district or by the Lapeer County Health Department.

ICS will continue to cooperate with the Lapeer County Health Department to assist in contact tracing and notification if there are any additional positive or probable school-associated cases. Additionally, our strict enforcement of health and safety guidelines will remain in place in order to limit transmission of COVID-19.

As always, to prevent the spread of COVID-19, individuals should:

- Stay home if sick
- Wash hands frequently
- Disinfect commonly touched surfaces
- Avoid touching face; avoid shaking hands
- Wear masks, as prescribed and follow suggested guidelines for social distancing

The building offices, as well as individual teachers, will reach out to quarantined students regarding work opportunities during the quarantine period.

A lo largo del día de hoy, se nos notificó que dos personas de la escuela primaria Borland dieron positivo en la prueba de COVID-19 y una persona de la escuela secundaria Imlay City fue identificada con un caso probable de COVID-19.

Se le ha recomendado al distrito que ponga en cuarentena a los estudiantes y al personal identificado como contactos cercanos con estas personas.

Tenga en cuenta que si su hijo fue considerado un contacto cercano, el distrito o el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Lapeer ya le habrían notificado.

ICS continuará cooperando con el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Lapeer para ayudar en la localización de contactos y la notificación si hay otros casos positivos o probables asociados con la escuela. Además, nuestra estricta aplicación de las pautas de salud y seguridad se mantendrá para limitar la transmisión de COVID-19.

Como siempre, para prevenir la propagación de COVID-19, las personas deben:

- Quédese en casa si está enfermo
- Lávese las manos con frecuencia
- Desinfecte las superficies que se tocan comúnmente
- Evite tocarse la cara; evitar dar la mano
- Use máscaras, según lo prescrito y siga las pautas sugeridas para el distanciamiento social
