Dear Spartan Families,

This afternoon, we were notified by the Lapeer County Health Department that an individual in one of our preschool classrooms, at Weston, has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual was also present in the childcare/latchkey classroom.

While this individual has not been present at school since Friday, October 23, the district has been advised to quarantine the preschool classroom through Friday, November 6. Additionally, while no students who attended latchkey are subject to any quarantine or isolation, our childcare/latchkey program will be temporarily closed through Friday, November 6. Childcare/latchkey will reopen for regularly scheduled hours on Monday, November 9, 2020.

The district is responsible for identifying all individuals who are considered close contacts according to the Centers of Disease Control guidelines. *If your student was considered a close contact to the affected individual, you would have already been contacted by the district or the Lapeer County Health Department.* At this time, due to the cleaning and preventative safety measures the district has put into place, no other classrooms in the building are affected. If you've not been contacted, please send your child to school as per his/her regular schedule.

ICS advises that all parents routinely monitor their child's health for any COVID-like symptoms (including fever or chills, cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing, diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain, new onset severe headache or new fatigue), and contact your child's healthcare provider with any health concerns.

As always, to prevent the spread of COVID-19, individuals should:

- Stay home if sick
- Wash hands frequently
- Disinfect commonly touched surfaces
- Avoid touching face; avoid shaking hands
- Wear masks, as prescribed and follow suggested guidelines for social distancing

Estimadas familias espartanas,

Esta tarde, el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Lapeer nos notificó que una persona en una de nuestras aulas preescolares, en Weston, dio positivo por COVID-19. Este individuo también estuvo presente en el aula de cuidado de niños / latchkey.

Si bien esta persona no ha estado presente en la escuela desde el viernes 23 de octubre, se le recomendó al distrito que ponga en cuarentena el aula preescolar hasta el viernes 6 de noviembre. Además, aunque ningún estudiante que asistió a latchkey está sujeto a cuarentena o aislamiento, nuestra guardería / El programa latchkey permanecerá cerrado temporalmente hasta el viernes 6 de noviembre. El cuidado de niños / latchkey volverá a abrir durante el horario regular programado el lunes 9 de noviembre de 2020.

El distrito es responsable de identificar a todas las personas que se consideran contactos cercanos de acuerdo con las pautas de los Centros de Control de Enfermedades. Si se consideró que su estudiante era un contacto cercano con la persona afectada, el distrito o el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Lapeer ya se habrían comunicado con usted. En este momento, debido a la limpieza y las medidas de seguridad preventivas que el distrito ha implementado, ningún otro salón de clases en el edificio se ve afectado. Si no ha sido contactado, envíe a su hijo a la escuela según su horario regular.

ICS aconseja que todos los padres controlen de forma rutinaria la salud de su hijo para detectar cualquier síntoma similar al COVID (como fiebre o escalofríos, tos, dolor de garganta, dificultad para respirar, diarrea, vómitos o dolor abdominal, dolor de cabeza severo de nueva aparición o fatiga nueva) y que se comuniquen con su hijo. proveedor de atención médica con cualquier problema de salud.

Como siempre, para prevenir la propagación de COVID-19, las personas deben:

- Quédese en casa si está enfermo
- Lávese las manos con frecuencia
- Desinfecte las superficies que se tocan comúnmente
- Evite tocarse la cara; evitar dar la mano
- Use máscaras, según lo prescrito y siga las pautas sugeridas para el distanciamiento social
