Dear Spartan Families,

This afternoon we were notified that an individual affiliated with Imlay City High School has been identified as having a probable case of COVID-19. Because of the proactive measures taken by the high school staff and administrators, no students have been identified as being a close contact to this individual, however two high school staff members will be quarantined as a precaution. We have worked closely with the Lapeer County Health Department to confirm this information.

No students will need to be quarantined as a result of this probable case of COVID. As such, this message is purely informational.

ICS advises that all parents routinely monitor their child's health for any COVID-like symptoms (including fever or chills, cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing, diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain, new onset severe headache or new fatigue), and contact your child's healthcare provider with any health concerns.

As always, to prevent the spread of COVID-19, individuals should:

- Stay home if sick
- Wash hands frequently
- Disinfect commonly touched surfaces
- Avoid touching face; avoid shaking hands
- Wear masks, as prescribed and follow suggested guidelines for social distancing

Esta tarde se nos notificó que un individuo afiliado a Imlay City High School ha sido identificado con un caso probable de COVID-19. Debido a las medidas proactivas tomadas por el personal y los administradores de la escuela secundaria, ningún estudiante ha sido identificado como un contacto cercano con esta persona; sin embargo, dos miembros del personal de la escuela secundaria serán puestos en cuarentena como medida de precaución. Hemos trabajado en estrecha colaboración con el Departamento de Salud del condado de Lapeer para confirmar esta información.

Ningún estudiante tendrá que ser puesto en cuarentena como resultado de este probable caso de COVID. Como tal, este mensaje es puramente informativo.

ICS aconseja que todos los padres controlen de forma rutinaria la salud de su hijo para detectar cualquier síntoma similar al COVID (como fiebre o escalofríos, tos, dolor de garganta, dificultad para respirar, diarrea, vómitos o dolor abdominal, dolor de cabeza severo de nueva aparición o fatiga nueva) y que se comuniquen con su hijo. proveedor de atención médica con cualquier problema de salud.

Como siempre, para prevenir la propagación de COVID-19, las personas deben:

- Quédese en casa si está enfermo
- Lávese las manos con frecuencia
- Desinfecte las superficies que se tocan comúnmente
- Evite tocarse la cara; evitar dar la mano
- Use máscaras, según lo prescrito y siga las pautas sugeridas para el distanciamiento social
