In adherence to the executive order from Governor Gretchen Whitmer, the Imlay City School district will be closed through April 13, 2020. All events, activities, and athletic programs (including practices), have been cancelled. All school buildings and facilities are closed to the public, including administrative offices. Some essential district-level personnel will report at this time.

We will continue to offer modified food service during this period of closure. However, to ensure we are providing this service while keeping the health of our families, staff and volunteers a priority, we will implement one change to our original plan.

All meals, for children 18 and under, will be provided through curbside pick-up only, from 4:00-7:00 PM on Tuesdays and Fridays. The pick-up location will be at Imlay City High School, in the front parking lot by the drop-off door. We ask that you remain in your vehicles and a volunteer will facilitate delivering meals to you.

More information about future learning opportunities will be coming soon. Additionally, we will continue to keep you informed of any other changes that occur in the coming days and weeks.
